Occupational Therapy (OT)

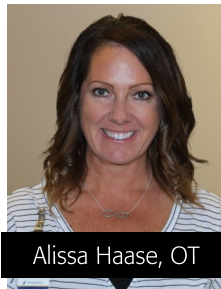
